1.b The South partner(s)

There has been contact between DDL and the deaf community in Jordan since the spring 2016 through a project funded by another donor. As a part of the CRPD review process, DDL's project coordinator has provided two rounds of trainings on the CRPD and parallel reporting in Jordan, in which ATDOC participated with a few participants. The visits gave DDL a good insight in the situation and needs of the deaf community in Jordan and enabled DDL to do a basic capacity and needs assessment, which showed a significant need for trainings to both the leadership and to the deaf community.

ATDOC has been identified as one of the most strong local deaf associations in Jordan with good ties to the (local) government, it has carried out several advocacy activities on e.g. disability rights and deaf education towards the government, international agencies such as UNHCR, and international donors. ATDOC is primarily working within the vicinity of Amman, its members met twice a week (Tuesdays and Thursdays). The main activities are:

- conducting sign language courses for hearing persons at three levels three times a week
- charity support for 150 Deaf orphans (provide food, clothing, etc.)
- conducting Islamic courses for Deaf persons
